Study Title: ISTIM-AD
(Individualized Stimulation to Improve Mobility in Alzheimer's Disease)

Study Goal: To test if non-invasive brain stimulation can improve memory, walking, and balance in older adults with memory problems.

Participation includes:

- Up to 16 visits over two months
- Memory and health assessments
- Noninvasive brain stimulation (10 visits, 30 mins each, Mon-Fri over two weeks)
- 2 MRI scans at Beth Israel in Boston (Optional)

Participation is paid up to \$250

Free parking and/or transportation
